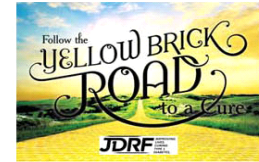
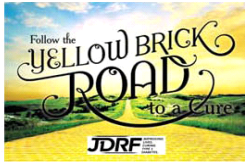

I ask for you to consider the JDRF Gala on October 20th:

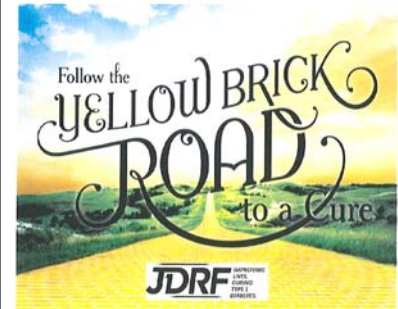
