

HFTP History

HFTP's roots stem from a number of state-centered accountant associations who thought it would be beneficial if they created a national network. Through the support of both the Texas Hotel Accountants Association and the Hotel Accountants of New York, the formal organization of the National Association of Hotel Accountants was formed on October 26, 1952 in New York City at the Hotel Lexington. Today HFTP has over 4,500 members.

- The National Association of Hotel Accountants (NAHA)
- The National Association of Hotel-Motel Accountants (NAHMA)
- The International Association of Hotel Accountants (IAHA)
- Hospitality Financial and Technology Professionals (HFTP)

HFTP Membership

HFTP membership is available to individuals interested in the hospitality industry. Since HFTP focuses on individual professional development, membership is individually-based, not company-based. Job titles of members include controller, director of finance, CFO, IT director and more.
